In 2022, the majority of the unemployed persons belongs to the age group 25-29 years old with 94,499 persons (16.7% of the total), while followed by the age group 40-44 years old with 74,748 persons (12.7%) and the age group 35-39 years old with 70,844 persons (12.0%).

In 2022 compared to 2021, unemployment decreased by 13.2% to 588,188 persons, with the largest decrease observed in the age groups 50-54 years old (-18.9%) and 30-34 years old (-18.7%). On the contrary, an increase was recorded in the unemployed aged 15-19 years old (23.7%) and 65-69 years old (6.7%).

Gradually, during the period 2015-2022, the age group with the highest decrease by percentage in unemployed persons is that of 30-34 years old (-64.3%). Following are the age groups 25-29 and 50-54 years old with percentages of decrease of -51.4% and -50.3%, respectively.

Among the unemployed who worked in the last 8 years, the majority of the employed were occupied in the following sectors (1st level of classification), in level of: Accommodation and food service activities (92,445), Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles (54,585) and Manufacturing (39,593).

In two of the above-mentioned sectors (Accommodation and food service activities, and Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles), the majority of the unemployed belongs to the age group 25-29 years old, with percentages of 18.9% and 25.4%, respectively, while most of the employed in the sector of Manufacturing belong to the age group 40-45 years old, with a rate of 18.5%.

Among the unemployed persons who worked in the last 8 years, the majority was occupied in the sectors of (2nd level of classification): Food and beverage service activities (51,973), Retail trade; except of motor vehicles and motorcycles (44,062) and Accommodation (40,472).

In two of the above-mentioned sectors (Food and beverage service activities, and Retail trade; except of motor vehicles and motorcycles), the majority of the unemployed belongs to the age group 25-29 years old, with percentages of 18.9% and 26.7%, respectively, while in the sector of Accommodation, most unemployed emerge from the age group 20-24 years old, with a rate of 15.8%.
