



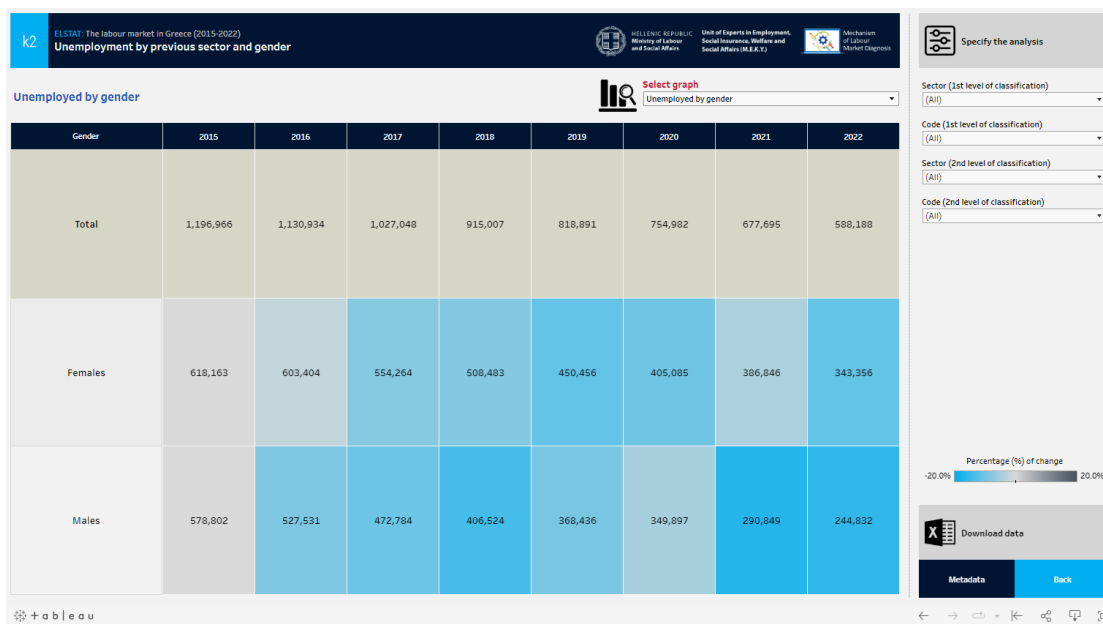
## k2. Unemployment by previous sector and gender<sup>1</sup>

### Unemployed by gender



In 2022, the unemployed amounted to 588,188, of which 343,356 were women (58.4% of the total), while 244,832 were men (41.6% of the total).

In 2022 compared to 2021, unemployment decreased by 13.2% to 588,188 persons, with the largest decrease observed among men (-15.8%) and the smallest decrease among women (-11.2%).

Gradually, during the period 2015-2022, a decrease in unemployment is noted in both genders, by 57.7% among men and 44.5% among women.

Among the unemployed who worked in the last 8 years, the majority of them was employed in the sectors (1st level of classification), in level of: Accommodation and food service activities (92,445), Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles (54,585) and Manufacturing (39,593), with the majority of the unemployed persons being women, with rates of 61.4%, 60.4% and 50.7%, respectively.

Among the unemployed who had worked in the last 8 years, the majority of them were employed in the sectors (2nd level of classification), in level of: Food and beverage service activities (51,973), Retail trade; except of the trade of motor vehicles and motorcycles (44,062) and Accommodation (40,472), with the majority of unemployed persons in the above-mentioned sectors being women, with rates of 58.5%, 68.7% and 65.2%, respectively.
